



Teaching teachers (and others) to save lives



BCEHS Education Officer Julia Strain taught six teachers from Smithers Senior Secondary School, two from Houston Secondary School and two RBC employees.

The teachers can now teach their students the fundamentals of CPR and defibrillator use. Dr. Darren Jakubec also spoke about the value of the instruction.

The Royal Bank of BC donated more than \$6,000 worth of equipment to the schools.

Together the Advanced Coronary Treatment (ACT) Foundation and BCEHS paramedics have trained more than 200,000 BC high school students in CPR and AED use.

Teachers trained by the ACT foundation have trained more than 3 million students, empowering them to be first in the chain of survival in a cardiac arrest.
